







## Nuclear summer school "the back-end of the nuclear fuel cycle in France"

The next Summer School will be organized, in France, from the 18<sup>th</sup> to the 22<sup>nd</sup> of September, 2017.

During a week, students from Czech Republic and Slovakia will have the opportunity to:

- Attend courses given by experts from the CEA and AREVA
- Visit the infrastructures dedicated to fuel reprocessing, on an industrial scale like **AREVA La Hague**
- Discover the facilities of the **CEA in Marcoule** (vitrification process, ATALANTE, ...)
- Visit the nuclear worksite of **Flamanville**, where the EPR is under construction







Only a **limited number of students** will be able to attend this Summer School. Selected students will be asked to present a feed-back of the training on the back-end of the fuel cycle at their Faculty on their return.

- 1. a CV and a cover letter explaining why you wish to participate to the Summer School
- 2. a short description of the way you intend to present the feed-back of the Summer School to you Faculty once back, if you were selected. The more innovative the presentation the better!
- 3. a copy of your ID/passport

The selection of students will be carried out by the CENEN and the French Embassy.

The deadline for submission is the 1th of June, 2017.
